

## School and Division Improvement Accountability Report

The Board received a presentation from our Superintendent of School Operations on School and Division Learning Improvement Plans (LIPs) from the 2021-2022 school year. The main focus of the school LIPs was on wellness and reconnection as well as learning goals such as reading, writing and math. Some schools had multiple goals. Of the 81 LIPs throughout our schools, most showed growth from what was originally targeted. At various times throughout the year and in certain communities, School Community Councils (SCCs) were uncomfortable meeting face-to-face due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic which led to lower SCC engagement results. All LIP goals are communicated to students, staff and parents/guardians several times throughout the school year.

## Student Support Services in Prairie South Schools

Our Superintendent of Learning, Amanda Olson, presented to the Board on the Who, What and Why of Student Support Services in Prairie South Schools. All students, all staff, parents/guardians, caregivers, outside agencies and community supports are part of Student Support Services. We use a needs-based model. All students have or will have accessed some form of student support service during their school journey. Every student has a unique learning profile and we help all students achieve at their highest potential. We put a lot of emphasis on ensuring individual students and their families are involved in decision making so we are all working towards a common goal. We have Learning Consultants, Student Support Consultants, Speech Language Pathologists and Assistants, Advocacy and Behaviour Consultants, Educational Psychologists, Coordinators and a Superintendent who support collaborate teams at the school level. Some students may also have outside agency involvement. But we are all working together to help students be successful and achieve at their highest level.
