## CHANGES TO BOARD POLICY 17 TRANSPORTATION

Prairie

The Board of Education has approved changes to *Board Policy 17 – Transportation* which will affect the walking distances for students who attend elementary schools in Moose Jaw. Prekindergarten and Kindergarten students will now qualify for busing if they live 500 meters from school and they can walk up to 500 meters to a bus stop. For Grades 1–8 students, the distance they can walk to a stop will be increased to 1 km.

Due to these Board-approved changes, Sunningdale School's walking circle map has been updated. Information will be shared with parents/guardians directly from the school. The walking circle map for our new Coteau Hills Elementary School on South Hill has also been approved. Parents will receive a communication from their school which will include the new walking circle map.
