2025-2026 BUDGET

Our Board of Education approved the budget for the 2025-2026 school year. The approved operating budget features \$110,759,381M in revenues and \$108,764,539M in expenses. After amortization, this creates a \$435,867 cash draw, which will be offset by using reserve funds. This budget is about supporting students - whether it is through classroom resources, teacher supports, or safe facilities.
