#### TRANSPORTATION BOARD POLICY

The Board recently reviewed and updated its Transportation Policy. The revisions include the addition of Alternate Yard Service, available only in rural areas for students attending a school outside their designated catchment area. Parents requesting this service must complete a Letter of Understanding, which requires approval from the Transportation Manager. The updated policy also outlines transportation provisions for French Immersion students attending École Palliser Heights School.

### BOARD REPS ON PROVINCIAL COMMITTEES

The Board nominates trustees annually to represent Prairie South for the Saskatchewan High Schools Athletic Association (SHSAA) and SSBA's Public Section. This year the Board nominated Brett Hagan for SHSAA and Mary Jukes for Public Section.

## STUDENT LEARNING ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

Prairie South School Division's 2024–2025 Student Learning Accountability Report highlights steady progress in literacy, numeracy, attendance, and graduation outcomes. Early reading and math data show strong student growth, with most achieving or exceeding grade-level expectations. Writing and math supports continue to strengthen instructional practices. Division-wide attendance rose to 91.37%, an increase of 0.53%. Initiatives like Prairie South Pathways and ongoing career development support students' success beyond high school. The division remains focused on implementing new provincial assessments and maintaining effective interventions to ensure all students achieve their full potential.
