BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

ANNUAL REPORT AND AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Board held a Special Board Meeting on November 25, 2025 to review the Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements. Our 2024-25 Annual Report highlights key achievements, priorities, and financial details for the school year. The division focused strongly on student attendance, connection and belonging, well-being, and academic growth.

We continued to see strong student outcomes, with improvements in Early Years Evaluation results, grade-level reading, credit attainment, and graduation rates, which exceeded provincial averages. Schools also strengthened community and family engagement through School Community Councils, literacy events, and cultural partnerships.

The audited financial statements show a strong and stable year for the division. We had a deficit on operations that was less than budgeted which reflects our careful budget management, continued investment in our schools and facilities, and overall responsible use of resources. The audit confirms that we are in a healthy financial position and well-equipped to continue supporting the educational needs and priorities of our students and staff.

FACILITIES ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT

The 2024–2025 Facilities Accountability Report highlights Prairie South’s continued focus on maintaining safe, efficient, and well-managed learning environments across a diverse portfolio of school facilities. With an average building age of 69 years and significant variation in utilization rates, the Facilities Department concentrated on strategic planning, preventative maintenance, and responsive service delivery.

Infrastructure investment remained a central priority, with more than \$18 million spent on major projects, including the new Coteau Hills Elementary School, HVAC upgrades, roof replacements, elevators, playgrounds, and mechanical systems across multiple schools. Preventative maintenance was strengthened through annual roof inspections, extensive safety and mechanical inspections, and enhanced building automation systems designed to reduce energy consumption.

The department continues to balance daily operational demands with proactive planning, new Joint Use School commitments, and ongoing efforts to enhance efficiency across the division. We would like to thank all facilities staff for the work they do keeping our schools and buildings safe, clean, and running smoothly.
