2026-2027 BUDGET APPROVED

Our Board of Education approved the budget for the 2026-2027 school year. The approved operating budget features \$109,180,690 in revenue, \$111,850,677 in expenses, capital purchases of \$2,520,300, and a cash draw of \$67,473. This budget reflects careful planning and a clear focus on what matters most – creating learning environments where students can thrive.
