Just over 5 million dollars was spent on infrastructure projects in our schools and buildings, from window replacements, lighting upgrades, asbestos remediation and more. Energy savings is a common goal with all our schools and sharing utility information will help school administration work towards that goal. Ensuring our schools are accessible for all has been a priority of ongoing projects for our facilities department. Work has started on tracking all accessibility systems (i.e., elevators, lifts, ceiling track systems, etc.) in our schools. We are proud of our facilities department and the excellent work they do on a daily basis to ensure all staff and students stay safe.
