Cornerstone Christian School



Cornerstone Christian School is a Pre-School to Grade 12 Associate School in Moose Jaw. Our current enrollment is 287 students which include 6 visiting international students from Japan and Brazil. We have a total of 40 staff members which includes teachers, a business manager, administrative assistants, educational assistants, a chaplain, a librarian, custodians, a concession worker, an IT technician, and bus drivers.



Clubs: With highly talented and dedicated staff come some very fun clubs for kids to keep busy at noon and after school. In elementary school, we offer a baking club, crochet club, and a worship arts group called Kingdom Kids. In high school our kids can hang out and do coding and robotics or play board games depending on the day.

Performing Arts: Each November, CCS produces a Broadway-style musical featuring students from grades 2–12, performed at the Mae Wilson Theatre. Past productions include Tarzan, The Little Mermaid, Newsies, and Les Misérables, with Disney's Frozen already booked for next year. Each winter and spring, our grades 7–12 theatre students compete in the Region 2 Drama Festival, advancing to Provincials multiple times in recent years and earning Best Overall Production at the Provincial Drama Festival in 2025. Beyond the stage, CCS partners with EF Tours to immerse students in arts and culture beyond our province, travelling to New York City in 2025 and heading to London, England in 2027.





Athletics: We offer almost every sport available to students, and if a sport is not offered in-house, we are blessed to be able to partner with other schools in Moose Jaw (Central for football and Peacock for soccer) to give our students every opportunity to play what they love.

Our volleyball teams perform at a provincial level most years and our senior badminton team has been City Champions for the past 5 years. We have been to Hoopla for basketball numerous times, and now curling is in full swing with hopes of earning a city medal. We are also so proud of our cross country and track athletes who work hard all year in training for their events.



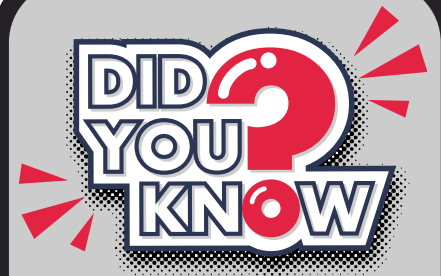
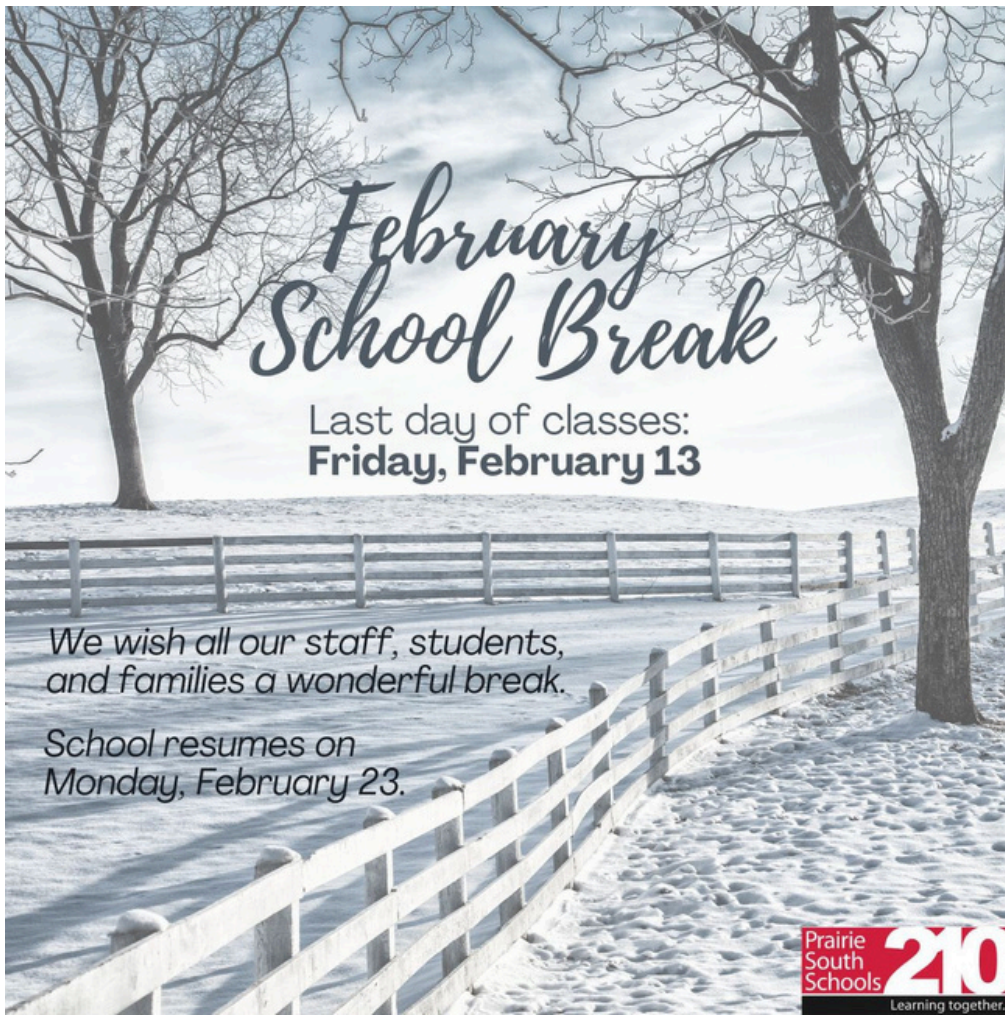


Choir/Vocal Jazz: Our high school choir is a popular group with 35 kids from grades 7-12. This group volunteers around the community bringing joy and song to the residents at Pioneer Lodge, Providence Place, music festivals, and the annual free Christmas concert at Hillcrest Church.

Moose Jaw Community Gardens: Our yearly grade 10 class outreach project is helping during the fall harvest and cleaning up at the Mosaic Community Food Farm.



Mission to Mexico: Each year, a team of students volunteer to go above ... and beyond Canadian borders ... to serve children, teens, and families in Merida, Mexico. Along with learning how to plan, prepare, fundraise, and engage in team work, these students experience new culture and new perspectives as we serve in rural Yucatan. Through running kids camps and connecting with other Christian leaders, these students experience life-changing moments in their personal and spiritual development, as well as make life-long friends and memories.



Prairie South is in the final stages of releasing a recruitment video which should be ready in the spring!

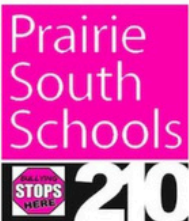
We interviewed 41 employees totalling over 5 hours of video, showcasing what it is like working for Prairie South and why others should work here!
