So, you're off to Saskatchewan Polytechnic. Congratulations!

Some handy reminders:

- All your correspondence with Sask. Poly is done through the portal. Ensure you accept your offer, pay the \$600 seat deposit within the time required, and ask questions through the portal. Also let them know if you are not attending so someone else can have your seat.
- Final <u>transcript request</u> done? Phone: 306.787.9525. These sites are helpful to understand MyCreds:

- Have you toured the campus? Check tour opportunities.
- Get to know what you'll be doing with a student orientation. <u>Virtual and in-person orientations</u> are available for you to learn more about Sask. Poly before you start school.
- Do you have a place to live? <u>Housing Registries</u> provide some options.
 <u>University of Regina Housing Services</u> is also available to Sask. Polytechnic students living in Regina.
- Student Loans: (Applications typically open in June.)
 - ⇒ Canada-Saskatchewan Student Loans
 - ⇒ <u>Student Financial Assistance Estimator</u> can be used to estimate the amount of a potential student loan.

- Some students may become apprentices after they attend Sask. Polytechnic.
 Check out Sask. Apprenticeship's trades list.
- Scholarships:
 - ⇒ Apply for <u>Polytechnic Scholarships</u>. There are several application periods, so be sure to check them accordingly.
 - ⇒ Many scholarship deadlines have passed, but there are others you can apply to receive over the next few months.

- <u>Learning Services</u> help is available to all students. They offer writing help, math assistance and group presentations (time management, study skills, exam preparation, exam anxiety, writing skills and math skills). Use it!
- If you have any type of disability (ADHD, anxiety, depression, any other mental health issues, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, or any other learning disability), contact <u>Saskpolytech Accessibility Services</u> to ensure you have everything you need set up before you get there. Do not delay.
- Health and dental plans: Students can opt out of health and dental plans, if they are covered by an equivalent or better plan. You can only submit this application in the fall, and usually, it must be completed by September 30. This can save you well over \$200 each year. Click here.
