

Engage Parents:

- Communicate the goals –student led conference, Newsletter, website, email, each class reports “I can” for newsletter based on school goals
- Tie an informational meeting into a fun activity i.e. education week
- Reading/Math info nights
- Open house –i.e. in fall with goals discussion, can do scavenger hunt (key info)
- Parent and student book club –parents reading the same book as their children
- Sign outdoors
- Early October –presenter (Learning Teams) to parents re: home reading/developing literacy
- Speak to parent individually about their kids (time consuming)
- School home page
- Student led conference LIP sample in student portfolio (section made by student)
- Literacy bins for early elementary students to take home/circulate
- Parent conference with sessions related to school goals –run by SCC
- Call in to help with activities, helpful tips at home
- Have parents as part of indicators (reading to parents)
- Community celebration when reach milestones
- SCC to help engage parents, students must engage their parents
- Using an “exit slip” activity which includes sharing with parents
- Snacks
- Parent evening, division resource
- Consider demographics, support goal once in place
- Using the parent conference to share the data and the plan
